



Economies of Intelligence Promote Knowledge Sharing

In the 1980s, medical data and evidence was doubling every 7 years.¹ By 2020, it was estimated to be doubling every 73 days.¹ To stay up to date on the latest clinical trials and new therapies, it is estimated that oncologists and clinicians would have to read up to 29 hours per day.¹ OneOncology recognizes the importance of economies of intelligence and knowledge sharing to address the challenges posed to physicians to stay up to date on clinical best practices with the influx of new information. OneCommunity is a communication platform that engages OneOncology physicians to:

- examine medical cases,
- weigh in on real-time questions,
- share information and resources, and
- identify potential clinical trials

Virtual tumor boards allow providers within the OneOncology network to collaborate with disease-specific experts and other physicians who may have cared for a similar case in order to provide insights, expertise, and resources to ensure patients receive the best care possible. OneCommunity is widely used by partner physicians with ~500 users and >60,000 tumor board views.
